

THE BASIC RULES FOR ACCESS AND MANAGEMENT OF YOUR PET ANIMAL IN THE CAMPSITE

This information note summarises some simple rules to be observed in order to access the Campsite with your pet animal. Respect for these few rules will allow both you and your pet to enjoy the experience of our Family Camping Villages in complete safety and relaxation.

1 First of all, remember that it is important to be fully aware of the Campsite regulations which, as well as being available to view online, can be obtained in reception. The regulations give the rules to be observed in the premises and, in particular, also the rules governing access and management of your pet.

2 Guests may access the premises only with animals that:

- are at least 4 months old;
- have a vaccination card;
- in the case of dogs, they must be regularly registered with the Canine Registry;
- In the case of both dogs and cats, they must have a health certificate issued by an official veterinarian, which also states that anti-parasitic treatments have been carried out (internal and external parasites) less than 21 days before entering the Campsite;
- with regard to cats, they must have a negative FiV FeLV test.

3 Guests must also:

- keep their dogs on a lead in all areas of the Campsite that can be generally accessed by guests, and always have with them a muzzle, to be used when needed (e.g. in crowded places, when the animal becomes restless, etc.) or when simply requested to do so by Campsite operators;
- observe the rules laid down for use of the “dog parks”;
- pick up their pets’ droppings and dispose of these according to the correct separation of waste.

4 Limitations on weight, size, breed and number of animals that can access the Campsite may be imposed by the Campsite Management. The Campsite Management is at your service to supply all necessary information.

5 Access of animals to the beach or to other places in the Campsite may be denied or limited to certain areas, just as the possibility of allowing animals to bathe in the sea or the swimming pools is also excluded as a rule. It is important to find out in advance from the Campsite Management what you can do with your pet in the Campsite and its adjacent areas.

6 Owners of animals and those managing them are responsible for any damage to people and/or things caused by them.

7 If guests have not notified the presence of their pet animal at the time of booking, they must register it when they arrive and this may require a change in the residential accommodation/pitch, to one that is suitable or located in a dedicated area of the Campsite. The access of a pet animal to the Campsite is in any case subject to observation of the rules described above.

8 Failure to observe the above-mentioned rules may incur the application of a fine of between €50 and €250, as well as the right of the Campsite Management to remove the guest from the premises.
